Sustainable Resource Management in the UNECE Region and beyond

Dependency on natural resources for economic development and human well-being and the low-carbon and low-emission transitions

Resource extraction and use pose challenges, such as land degradation, greenhouse gas emissions, biodiversity loss, and social opposition

ECE subprogramme on sustainable energy supports UN Member States to balance resource use and conservation through transformation and innovation at all societal levels

The subprogramme develops and implements two complementary frameworks: **United Nations Framework Classification for Resources** and **United Nations Resource Management System**

Expert Group on Resource Management (EGRM)



EGRM has over **300 active members** representing governments (UNECE & non-UNECE), industry, international organizations, civil society, professional societies & associations, financial sector, academia and UN bodies

20+ Working Groups and Task Forces work continuously **to advise** EGRM's parent inter-governmental body, the **UNECE Committee on Sustainable Energy**

Membership in EGRM is **open to anyone** interested in the sustainable management of resources




UNFC and UNRMS



- The Expert Group on Resource Management (EGRM) develops and supports implementation and adoption of **UNFC** and **UNRMS**
- Apply to all energy and mineral resources (primary and secondary raw materials), injection projects, groundwater, hydrogen
- Focus on applying **UNFC** and **UNRMS** to critical raw materials and enabling circularity in resource use, essential for the transition to a net-zero economy
- Resource servitization
